DATE OF COMPETITION:	FEBRUARY 16, 2023 TO FEBRUARY 19, 2023
QUALIFYING PERIOD:	UNTIL FEBRUARY 14, 2023

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for selection, the swimmer must meet ALL of the following eligibility criteria:

1. Be a **FILIPINO CITIZEN**, eligible to represent The Philippines.
2. Times must be achieved in a long course individual event: relay lead-off times, intermediate splits or swim-off results will not be considered for individual event selection purposes.
3. Met the Qualifying Standards of the **Cambodia 2023 32nd SEA Games Philippine National Tryouts** organized by PSI - Stabilization Committee.
4. The swimmer who has not achieved the **QT-A** Qualifying Standard but is among the Top 2 fastest time in any event in the Philippine Ranking within the Qualifying Period may also be considered for selection (**QT-B**). Provided that, **the swimmer complies with all the eligibility requirements.**
5. Has not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluid, would have constituted doping, or use any prohibited method or committed any other doping offense as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By-Law.
6. No individual can perform the role of both participating swimmer and coach at the same meet.

Once qualified, each swimmer **SHALL:**

- Continuously train and must maintain their **PEAK PERFORMANCE** until the date of the 32nd Southeast Asian Games – Cambodia 2023.
- Prioritize all the TEAM Commitments following the selection. (see Team Commitment section).
- Will not any time until the date of the 32nd Southeast Asian Games – Cambodia 2023 use or administer any substance which, if detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluid, would constitute doping, or use any prohibited method or committed any doping offense as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti Doping-By-Law



SELECTION MEETS	The February 16 to 19, 2023, SEA Games Philippine National Tryouts is the ONLY Qualifying National Selection meet authorized by the World Aquatics, formally known as FINA .
AGE	Open to 14 years old and above .
FUNDING AND EXPENSES	Qualified Swimmers will be fully funded by the PSI - Stabilization Committee, Philippine Olympic Committee and the Philippine Sports Commission.
PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENT	<p>To be considered in the selection for individual events in the 32ND Southeast Asian Games, Cambodia 2023, swimmers are required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Achieve QT-A Qualifying Standard as shown below in the Table during the <u>Cambodia 2023 32nd SEA Games Philippine National Tryouts</u> organized by PSI - Stabilization Committee.2. In case one (1) swimmer has met the QT-A Qualifying Standard in a particular event, the top one (1) fastest swimmer based on Philippine Ranking (QT-B) will be considered.3. In case no swimmer has met the QT-A Qualifying Standard in a particular event, the top two (2) fastest swimmers based on Philippine Ranking (QT-B) will be considered <p>Criteria Selection for Relay Events for SEA Games proper:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Selections for relay will be done by ranking of swimmers based on times achieved during the Qualifying Period.2. In the 100m and 200M Freestyle Events, the third and fourth ranked swimmers will be nominated to compete in the 4x100m and 4x200m Freestyle Relays<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The best team will be put on the blocks to represent the Philippines.3. The Medley Relay Team will be composed of the fastest swimmer within the qualifying window in the individual event of the 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke, 100m Butterfly and 100m Freestyle or the fastest combination of swimmers possible.



	<p>4. The final decision of the composition of the relay teams will be made by the National Head Coach</p>
<p>TEAM COMMITMENT</p>	<p>Once selected, ALL Athletes and Officials must:</p> <p>1. At all times, comply with the provisions of PSI – Stabilization Committee Athlete’s Agreement.</p> <p>ATHLETE’S Agreement will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide and send an acceptable training plan with the respective coach in preparation for the SEA GAMES – Cambodia 2023.• Submission of training attendance throughout the training period.• Make themselves available for all team activities designated by PSI - Stabilization Committee.• Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or PSI – Stabilization Committee into public disrepute.• Swimmers and Officials are required to appear at any event whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve PSI – Stabilization Committee’s objectives• Qualified National Team members are required to undergo a four week training program with the entire Philippine National Team under the direct supervision of the PSI – Stabilization Committee, prior to send off. <p>*All required information pursuant to the Athlete’s Agreement must be emailed to: aquatics.stab.comm@gmail.com</p>
